
In order to protect all members of our community and workforce, we decided with the agreement of our Commissioners on the following changes to our service:

- All efforts will be focused on garbage pickup at this time.
- If you recycle and place recycling at the curb, we will collect with your garbage.
- There will be limited Yard Waste collection so your normal collection will most likely be delayed.

All employees have been briefed about the importance of using personal protective equipment and have been provided with supplies for health and safety to include the sanitizing of trucks and equipment each day.
